

"Quick & Easy Sewing Machine Cover-up"

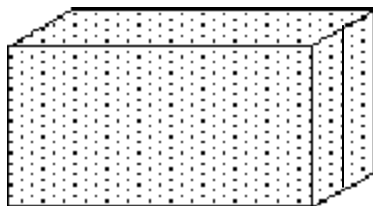

Only 4 Seams!

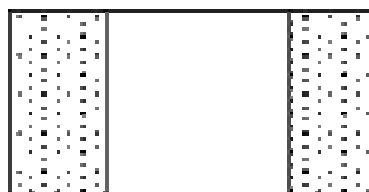
Materials:

- 22" x 44" piece of fabric
- 22" square of Airtex batting or
Cut a 22" piece of batting from
Airtex Roll and Quilt

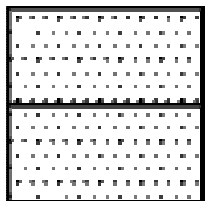
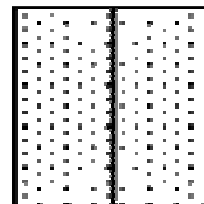


Sewing:

1. Open the 22" x 44" piece of fabric
2. Set the batting piece in the center of the fabric

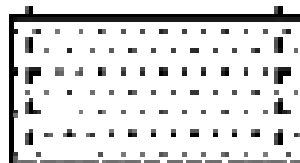


3. Fold the ends of the fabric over batting to meet in the center

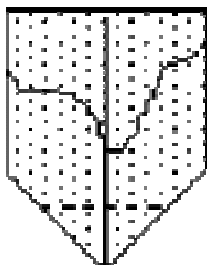


4. Turn the layered fabric so that the opening is in the middle

5. Fold the cover as shown and match the bottom edges and sew both sides with a 1/2" seam, being careful to include all layers.



6. Fold the cover as shown and make a "milk carton" corner. Stitch 2 1/2" from the end. Do this on both ends.



Turn the cover inside out and enjoy your new sewing machine cover!
